**Full Mainlane Weekend Closure of Interstate 35E at Beckley Avenue,
November 1-2**

DALLAS – All lanes of north- and southbound I-35E at Beckley Avenue will be closed from 9 p.m. Friday, November 1 through 2 p.m. Saturday, November 2.

During this closure, both north- and southbound lanes of the Beckley Avenue bridge will also be closed.

Southbound I-35E traffic will take the Beckley Ave/12th St. exit, continue on the southbound frontage road to the temporary I-35E entrance ramp

Northbound I-35E traffic will take the temporary northbound frontage road exit ramp after Beckley Avenue and continue on the northbound frontage road to the temporary I-35E entrance ramp.



Closures are subject to change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

A detour map is attached to this email.

About the Southern Gateway Project

The Southern Gateway Project is a \$666 million design-build construction project by the Texas Department of Transportation aimed to rebuild and widen I-35E south of downtown Dallas, as well as widen U.S. 67 between I-35E and I-20 and the I-35E/U.S. 67 split. Construction will also include building two reversible, non-tolled express lanes. The goal of the 11-mile project is to improve safety, provide congestion relief, address roadway deficiencies and improve system linkage. Construction began in early 2018 with an anticipated completion of late 2021. The Southern Gateway Project is part of the Texas Clear Lanes initiative (www.texasclearlanes.com) by TxDOT to address growing traffic congestion in the state.
